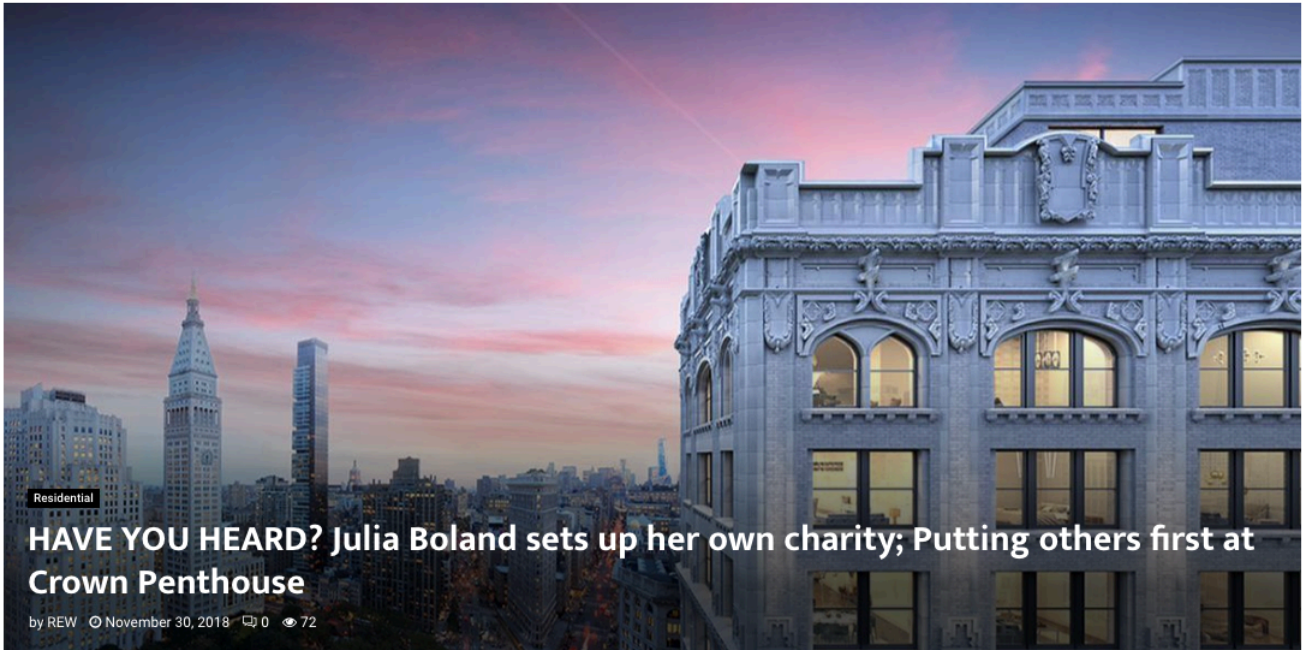

The 15,000 s/f home at 212 Fifth Avenue has been the venue for a host of charity events while it sits primed for a potential buyer.

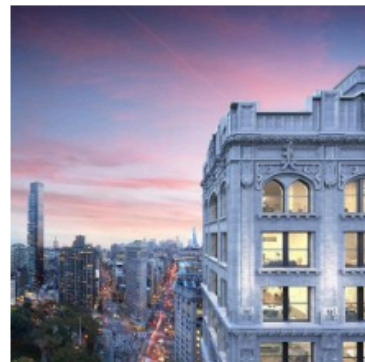
Last month, the International Chamber Orchestra of America (ICOA) was in the penthouse for a fundraiser to support music development for children.
